From the Native Americans who first tamed the lakeside wilderness to the French and British settlers who harnessed its natural resources to the wealthy auto barons who built magnificent homes, the area presents a unique panorama of a uniquely American social and cultural history.

The Grosse Pointe Historical Society was founded more than 60 years ago with the mission to celebrate and preserve the rich history of this area. This history is a valuable part of our lives, connecting us to our past and enriching us with insight about who we are today. To this end, the Society sponsors interactive programs and manages facilities that preserve and protect important artifacts.

The Provencal-Weir House, c. 1823, the oldest frame French farmhouses in Grosse Pointe, was restored by the Society. Its authentic restoration provides visitors a glimpse into domestic life in the early days of Grosse Pointe. It is available for meetings and events hosted by local organizations and members of the Historical Society.

Education events are created to enable adults and children the opportunity to gain a deeper appreciation for history through hands-on experiences, lectures, seasonal tours and other events.



Bronze markers are presented annually by the Society to residences, buildings and sites of historical significance in the area.

The Resource Center was established to assist visitors with

scholarly or personal investigations concerning the history of Grosse Pointe. The library and archive collection preserves maps, manuscripts, newspapers, magazine clippings, genealogical materials and memorabilia.

Lectures and classes are designed to appeal to a wide audience and include historical, archival or architectural topics.
