Time Traveler's Camp is for children aged 7-11 and is held at the Provencal-Weir House located at 376 Kercheval Avenue in GPF. Coming to the Provencal-Weir House gives children an opportunity to travel back in time in an authentic ribbon farm house that is almost 200 years old. Being able to create crafts and do old fashioned "chores" in the house is a truly unique experience for the children. The instruction and supervision is provided by two experienced classroom teachers, with a student-teacher ratio of six to one. All material fees are included for these "take home" projects.



The craft projects for 2017 include King Arthur costume making, sewing puppets, building birch bark canoes, assembling ships, painting ships, painting rope coasters and patio napkins, decorating summer votives, creating fairy gardens, soap making, painting horses, making your own Hunt Club barn, sewing a stuffed fox, dipping beeswax taper candles, making a braided rug, and baking summer cobbles, pies and muffins with fresh Michigan fruit. Weather permitting, lunches will be held out of doors, picnic style, with lots of outside play done with vintage toys.
